- Complete this Scholarship Application **and** submit it to the Student Services office by March 15th. Include your essay and activities page.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE:

For the 2008-09 academic years, the campus awarded 78 scholarships totaling \$72,000.00 to students attending UW-Marshfield/ Wood County. The average scholarship is \$958.00 for a full-time student. Of the many scholarships available, some are "general" and open to all students who meet the general scholarship criteria.  - Stratford State Bank (Must be a resident of Stratford)
